

Hints and Tips

Here are some hints and tips to have the best party for your child.

Hint 1

I know this might sound obvious but all entertainers are not the same. The best thing to do is to hire a professional, experienced entertainer; preferably one that comes on a friend's, or your child's recommendation.

Hint 2

Make sure the entertainers you hire are fully police checked (CRB)

Hint 3

Always try to book the children's entertainer before you book the venue, as there is usually a greater choice of venues in your local area compared to the number of entertainers.

Hint 4

When decorating the room try to avoid putting balloons on the floor - even though it looks good some children are afraid of them, especially if they pop.

Hint 5

If you are organising the games yourself try to write down what games you are going to play and in what order.

Try to play games or adjust the games so that the children are not out, as they will get bored standing around waiting for the game to finish and end up running around.

Hint 6

Try to avoid party blowers during the party as the noise can get very loud and you can lose control.

Another point about party blowers is that some entertainers might use rabbits etc and they don't like the sound they make.

Hint 7

When the children arrive get a contact number for the parents, just in case.

Hint 8

If you are having an entertainer and you are not sure about anything just ask them. They have a lot of experience with parties and are always happy to help you have a smooth running party.

Hint 9

Try to have the entertainer there as the children arrive as it helps the children get accustomed to them.
